CATECHIST CERTIFICATION

PURPOSE

The goal of Catechist Certification is to:

- prepare teachers to have a basic and deeper understanding of their (the) Catholic faith
- help teachers infuse the Catholic faith throughout the curriculum

CATECHIST CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

There are two types of certification necessary for teachers of Utah Catholic schools:

- **BASIC Certification:** All contract teachers, regardless of grade level or subject, must obtain Basic Certification by June 2026 or within two years of their hire date. Basic Certification requires 30 hours of coursework across the designated domains. Employees who hold a BA or MA in Theology, an MA in Catholic School Leadership, or are members of a religious community automatically qualify for Basic Certification.
- **RENEWAL Certification:** After receiving a Basic Certification, contract teachers will renew a minimum of 10 hours every year within the domains below.
