### LEVEL K

STANDARD 1: CREED - Students will demonstrate understanding of core Catholic beliefs.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Explain that God made all people out of love.
- 2. Identify that each person is special because of God's love.
- 3. Identify Jesus as our Friend and Brother.

STANDARD 2: WORSHIP AND SACRAMENTS - Students will demonstrate understanding and practice of Catholic worship and sacraments with an emphasis on the centrality of the Eucharist in the life of Catholics.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- 1. Celebrate Mass with the school student body at least once a month.
- 2. Understand that Mass is a time for a faith community to gather weekly and worship God.

STANDARD 3: MORALITY - Students will understand right from wrong and be able to make good moral choices in life decisions that are consistent with Church teachings and a Christian life style.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Explain the difference between right and wrong.
- 2. Explain why they made a particular choice and the consequences of their choice.
- 3. Participate in the school program for teaching and living a Christian life (virtues, life skills, Christian themes, etc.).
- 4. Explain how families help us live our faith.
- 5. Participate in the character education.

STANDARD 4: SOCIAL JUSTICE - Students will demonstrate understanding of Catholic social teaching and apply these principles to social and personal situations.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Demonstrate respect for all creation.
- 2. Demonstrate the dignity of the human person in work and play.
- 3. Explain how families are a sign of God's love.
- 4. Appreciate the diverse roles of members in a community.
- 5. Actively participate as members of a community.
- 6. Understand the relationship between actions and consequences.
- 7. Students will be involved in service projects throughout the year.

STANDARD 5: CORE SCRIPTURE - Students will read, interpret and apply Scripture to their own daily life situation.

#### OBJECTIVES

- 1. Retell stories from the Christian Scriptures (New Testament): Jesus' birth, Jesus' miracles, Jesus' death and resurrection.
- 2. Become familiar with some stories from Hebrew Scripture (Old Testament): Creation, Noah, David, etc.
- 3. Reverence the Bible as a special holy book, the Word of God.
- 4. Introduce and be familiar with Scripture verses appropriate to the curriculum.
- 5. Devotions will be discussed in connection with a Bible verse.

STANDARD 6: FAMILY LIFE - Students will demonstrate their understanding of Christian family life and how it is nourished and passed on.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Understand that God made all kinds of families that grow and change.
- 2. Able to explain how family, friends and parish families show love.
- 3. Understand that God gave the gift of life.
- 4. Understand that girls can grow up to be mothers and boys can grow up to be fathers.
- 5. Understand that a baby is a gift from God that helps a family's love grow.
- 6. Understand that God is forgiving and wants us to be kind, fair, and truthful.

STANDARD 7: LITURGICAL YEAR - Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Liturgical year and how it is celebrated.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Know that there are special times in the year we celebrate, especially Advent and Christmas, Lent and Easter.
- 2. Participate in activities and prayer that celebrates Christmas and Easter.
- 3. Recognize the Saints (Mary, Guardian Angels, St. Francis, and St. Nicholas) on their feast days.

STANDARD 8: CHRISTIAN PRAYER AND PRACTICE - Students will be able to demonstrate, understand, use and identify traditional prayer forms in the Catholic tradition.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Experience a variety of prayer forms including: silence, listening, song, gesture, spontaneous petitions and prayers of thanksgiving.
- 2. Refer to "Continuum of Prayers Taught" and especially be familiar with the rosary and the stations of the cross as prayers.

# RELIGION

#### LEVEL 1

- 4. Reverence of the Bible as a special holy book, the Word of God.
- 5. Continue to introduce and be familiar with Scripture verses appropriate to the curriculum.

STANDARD 6: FAMILY LIFE - Students will demonstrate their understanding of Christian family life and how it is nourished and passed on.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Explain how families work, love, care, share and have fun together.
- 2. Understand that God makes and loves all people as they are.

- 10. Understand the needs and wants of being a family.

#### LEVEL 2

- 5. Can explain that a wedding is a time when a man and a woman make an important promise.
- 6. Understand that a baby is a gift of life from God.
